2021-2022 ACADEMIC YEAR FALL TERM PLACEMENT TEST AND PROFICIENCY EXAMS

In order to start their departmental courses, students who are registered in programs in which the medium of instruction is English are required to be exempted from the English Preparatory Program.

Every student who is required to study the preparatory program and wants to take a preparatory program **must attend the Placement Exam (Beykoz PLET)** held at the beginning of the academic year.

In our school,

1. At first, you need to take the Beykoz Placement Test (PLET),
2. And then, according to your Beykoz PLET result*, you can take the English Proficiency Exam (Beykoz Proficiency Test (Beykoz PROF)).

***IMPORTANT NOTE:** Students who answered below 30 (net) questions correctly in the Placement Exam **cannot take** the English Proficiency Exam (Beykoz Prof). They are appointed to the classrooms according to their levels and they study at the English Preparatory Program.

Beykoz PLET-Exam consists of a total of 60 (sixty) multiple choice questions prepared to assess students'

- vocabulary knowledge,

- grammar knowledge,

- reading skills,

- and a writing section in which a paragraph will be written about one of the topics students can choose.

- ✓ The test lasts approximately **2 (two) hours** and there is no break during the exam.
- ✓ Since **one correct answer will be deducted for every 4 (four) incorrect answers**, students to take this exam are advised not to answer any questions that they are not sure of.
- ✓ Beykoz-PLET exam results will be announced on the web page of School of Foreign, at the sub-link of "Announcements".
- ✓ Students who answer 30 or more questions out of 60 (sixty) asked in this exam are deemed to have "successful" in the Beykoz-PLET Exam, and **they have the right to take the English Proficiency (Beykoz-PROF) Exam.**

ATTENTION! English Proficiency Exam (Beykoz-PROF) is for the students who are able to answer at **least 30 questions** correctly out of 60 in the Placement Test (Beykoz-PLET).

- English Proficiency Test (Beykoz-PROF) is held in two sessions: "written" and "spoken".
- Written session lasts approximately 3 hours.
- After the written session, “speaking exam” is given.
- Students will be called to the “speaking session” according to the appointment hours announced to them on the notice boards.
- Since **one correct answer will be deducted for every 4 (four) incorrect answers**, students to take this exam are advised not to answer any questions that they are not sure of.
- Written session has multiple choice questions (upper-intermediate level) to assess students' **vocabulary, grammar, reading and listening skills** and a section to assess their **writing skills**.

Classes will start on **Monday, October 18, 2021**.
