

2023-2024 Spring Term Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Studies and Student Mobility for Traineeships Application Announcement

Scope of Erasmus + Student Studies and Erasmus+ Student for Traineeships Mobility
For the 2023-2024 Spring Semester, the applicants who have the following European centers that we have contracted with or who want to do internship will go abroad.

- Study Mobility quota for 2022 Grant Agreement is **5**
- Traineeships Mobility quota for 2022 Grant Agreement is **1**

Application Conditions

1. At any of the formal education levels within the student's higher education institution(first, second or third cycle) enrolled in a higher education program, full-time being a student,
2. Must be at least a **2nd** year student when abroad,
3. Having a cumulative grade point average of **at least 2.20/4.00**,
4. Have enough (30) ECTS credits for mobility,
5. If you have participated in Erasmus before, the start of mobility with a new activity should not exceed 12 months.
6. Students who do not have an **Invitation Letter** for Erasmus Student **Traineeships Mobility** application will not be evaluated.

Informations

- Applications will be made between **23.10.2023** and **08.11.2023**.
- Applications will be received **online** via the Turkish National Agency's Erasmus Application Portal (<https://erasmusbasvuru.ua.gov.tr/giris?returnUrl=%2F>).
The universities you choose through the Erasmus Application Portal will vary later.
- Students must fill in the application completely by **16.00 on 08.11.2023 at the latest**.
- There are online application upload formulas for the TOEFL, PTE or equivalent exam results approved by YÖK, and transcripts showing the foreign language exams, if any.
- Applications made after this target will not be considered.
- Applications with incomplete documents will not be accepted.

Foreign Language Proficiency Exam

Among the students whose applications have been evaluated and accepted, those who do not have any foreign language proficiency certificate will take the exam on **20.11.2023** at **10.00** in the **Preparatory Campus Classroom 305**. The exam will be written only.

Criteria when evaluating applications:

Total 100 points;

- Academic success level: 50%
- Language level: 50%

Not taking the language exam without an excuse (applicable if the student re-applies to Erasmus)

- Students studying in a double major can apply for mobility from only one major in the same application period.
- Students who are in the last year of their undergraduate period can only apply for placement mobility. They can do internship mobility within 12 months after graduation.
